About the definition of terminology

“Video image”
“Video image” in this manual indicates the moving images of iPod, and any equipment that is connected to this system with an RCA cable, such as general-purpose AV equipment.

Important Safety Information

-  **WARNING**
- Do not attempt to install or service your navigation system by yourself. Installation or servicing of the navigation system by persons without training and experience in electronic equipment and automotive accessories may be dangerous and could expose you to the risk of electric shock or other hazards.

- When a route is calculated, the route and voice guidance for the route are automatically set. Also, for day or time traffic regulations, only information about traffic regulations at the time when the route was calculated is shown. One-way streets and street closures may not be taken into consideration. For example, if a street is open during the morning only, but you arrive later, it would be against the traffic regulations so you cannot drive along the set route. When driving, please follow the actual traffic signs. Also, the system may not know some traffic regulations.

Before using your navigation system, be sure to read and fully understand the following safety information:

-  Read the entire manual before operating this navigation system.
-  The navigation features of your navigation system (and rear view camera option if purchased) are intended solely as an aid to you in the operation of your vehicle. It is not a substitute for your attentiveness, judgement, and care when driving.
-  Do not operate this navigation system (or the rear view camera option if purchased) if doing so will divert your attention in any way from the safe operation of your vehicle. Always observe safe driving rules and follow all existing traffic regulations. If you experience difficulty in operating the system or reading the display, park your vehicle in a safe location and apply the handbrake before making the necessary adjustments.
-  Never allow others to use the system unless they have read and understood the operating instructions.
-  Never use this navigation system to route to hospitals, police stations or similar facilities in an emergency. Stop using any functions relating to the hands-free phone and please call the appropriate emergency number.

-  Route and guidance information displayed by this equipment is for reference purposes only. It may not accurately reflect the latest permissible routes, road conditions, one way streets, road closures, or traffic restrictions.
-  Traffic restrictions and advisories currently in force should always take precedence over guidance given by the navigation system. Always obey current traffic restrictions, even if the navigation system provides contrary advice.

-  Never set the volume of your navigation system so high that you cannot hear outside traffic and emergency vehicles.

-  Please remember to fasten your seat belt at all times while operating your vehicle. If you are ever in an accident, your injuries can be considerably more severe if your seat belt is not properly buckled.

- ❑ Be sure to attach the navigation system to the cradle during in-car use. Use of this navigation system when not firmly attached to the cradle, could result in damage to it in the event of a sudden stop.
- ❑ Never use headphones while driving.

Cautions for the AC adapter and the power cable usage

- ⚠ WARNING**
- Be sure to use only the supplied AC adapter with this product. Use of another AC adapter is dangerous and could result in malfunction.
 - Never touch the adapter when your hands or feet are wet. Also, do not use the adapter in a high moisture environment.
 - Allow adequate ventilation around the adapter when using it to operate the navigation system or charge the battery. Do not cover the AC adapter and the navigation system with paper or other objects that could reduce cooling.
 - Connect the AC adapter to an outlet that supplies the required voltage. The voltage requirements are found on the bottom of AC adapter.
 - Do not use the AC adapter or power cable if damaged.
 - Unplug the AC adapter and power cable from the outlet when not in use.
 - Never attempt to disassemble the AC adapter or power cable.
 - When disconnecting the AC adapter or power cable, pull the plug itself. Do not disconnect by pulling on the cable. 

Cautions for the battery pack

- ⚠ DANGER**
- Danger of explosion if battery is incorrectly replaced. Replace only with the same or equivalent type.
 - Keep the battery pack out of the reach of small children to prevent them from accidentally swallowing it.
 - Do not use a damaged or leaking battery pack. In the event of battery leakage, wipe the battery pack completely clean and replace it with a new battery.
 - Do not subject the battery pack to shock or impact.
 - Be sure to use only the supplied battery pack with this product. Use of another battery is dangerous and could result in malfunction.
 - Do not handle the battery with metallic tools. Do not store the battery with metallic materials.
 - Remove the battery if the navigation system is not to be used for a month or longer.

Additional supplement

- ❑ When you run this navigation system on power from the built-in battery alone, refrain from connecting an iPod to the navigation system to prevent the battery exhaustion.
- ❑ The battery lifetime is limited. Charged battery duration will decrease with repetitive charging. If the battery duration is extremely short, it may be near the end of battery life span. Consult your dealer or the nearest authorized Pioneer Service Station and replace it with a new battery pack.

About warning function for safety cameras

About speed limit indication

The speed limit is based on the map database. The speed limit in the database may not match the actual speed limit of the current road. This is not a definite value. Be sure to drive according to the actual speed limit. 

Additional Safety Information

Handbrake interlock

Certain functions (such as viewing of “Video image” and certain touch panel key operations) offered by this navigation system could be dangerous and/or unlawful if used while driving. To prevent such functions from being used while the vehicle is in motion, there is an interlock system that senses when the handbrake is set and when the vehicle is moving. If you attempt to use the functions described above while driving, they will become disabled until you stop the vehicle in a safe place, and apply the handbrake. Please keep the brake pedal pushed down before releasing the handbrake.

- ⚠ WARNING**
- **LIGHT GREEN LEAD AT POWER CONNECTOR IS DESIGNED TO DETECT PARKED STATUS AND MUST BE CONNECTED TO THE POWER SUPPLY SIDE OF THE HANDBRAKE SWITCH. IMPROPER CONNECTION OR USE OF THIS LEAD MAY VIOLATE APPLICABLE LAW AND MAY RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DAMAGE.**
 - To avoid the risk of damage and injury and the potential violation of applicable laws, the navigation system is not for use with a “Video image” that is visible to the driver.
 - In some countries the viewing of “Video image” on a display inside a vehicle even by persons other than the driver may be illegal. Where such regulations apply, they must be obeyed.
 - When applying the handbrake in order to view “Video image” or to enable other functions offered by the navigation system, park your vehicle in a safe place, and keep the brake pedal pushed down before releasing the handbrake if the vehicle is parked on a hill or otherwise might move when releasing the handbrake.

Additional Safety Information

When you attempt to watch “Video image” while driving, the warning “**Viewing of front seat video source while driving is strictly prohibited.**” will appear on the screen. To watch “Video image” on this display, stop the vehicle in a safe place and apply the handbrake. Please keep the brake pedal pushed down before releasing the handbrake. 

To avoid battery exhaustion

Be sure to run the vehicle engine when the navigation system is used attached to the cradle. Using this navigation system without running the engine can result in battery drainage during in-car use.

- ⚠ WARNING**
- Do not use with vehicles that do not feature an ACC position. 

Rear view camera

With an optional rear view camera, you are able to use the navigation system as an aid to keep an eye on trailers, or backing into a tight parking spot.

- ⚠ WARNING**
- SCREEN IMAGE MAY APPEAR REVERSED.
 - USE INPUT ONLY FOR REVERSE OR MIRROR IMAGE REAR VIEW CAMERA. OTHER USE MAY RESULT IN INJURY OR DAMAGE.

- ⚠ CAUTION**
- The rear view camera function is not available for safety reasons until the navigation system boots up completely.
 - The rear view mode is to use the navigation system as an aid to keep an eye on the trailers,

or while backing up. Do not use this function for entertainment purposes. 

Handling the SD card slot

- Keep the SD memory card out of the reach of small children to prevent them from accidentally swallowing it.
 - To prevent data loss and damage to the storage device, never remove it from this navigation system while data is being transferred.
